LOVE EXPRESSED



How do you express your love to family, friends, and strangers? For some it is harder than for others. Some of us are naturally more effusive and generous with our emotions while others of us are shy and reticent to express our feelings. No matter our temperaments and preferences, God desires that each of us express our love to one another no matter how hard (and risky) it may be at times. The way we show our love makes a difference in people's lives, especially our loved ones.

God does not keep us guessing as to whether he loves us or not. When we reach out to him for love, he happily takes us into his arms, despite how we may have hurt and neglected him. (In fact, even before we reach out to him, he has been reaching out to us.) God's heart is not Grinch-like, two sizes too small. God's heart is big and fearless and willing and able to love because he is selfless. When God expresses his love, it's not about him - it's about us (John 3:16).

God's greatest expression of love was giving us his Son, Jesus. Would you hand over your son to save the world, knowing what the world would do to him? God did. He went all the way – giving up all he had and enduring the worst kind of pain – all for us. This is perfect love.

God's love also shows itself in grief and even anger when we turn from him and sin against him and others. He will do what it takes to bring us back to him, and this always requires pain on our part. Are we willing to undergo what it will take to enjoy intimacy with your Heavenly Father? Are



you willing to hand your heart, your past, your sexuality, your insecurity, your pride and fear over to him?


What are you willing to endure, give up, or face that will help your child know God as Father
