Keep Asking to Receive

Christmas is a time of giving, but it is also a time of asking. We ask our loved ones and children, "What do you want for Christmas?" I ask you, reader of this newsletter, "What do you want?" A blind beggar sat beside the road begging and crying out, "Have mercy on me, Jesus!" and Jesus asked him outright, "What do you want me to do for you?" The blind man said, "Lord, I want to see." Jesus gave him sight, and the man followed him, rejoicing.



Often, we ask God for something and we don't receive it immediately, or it doesn't come to us in the way we had expected. We can understandably get confused and disappointed, and we sometimes give up asking. But if we really want something, we keep asking God for it. Matthew 7:7-8 is correctly translated as follows: "Keep on asking, and you will receive what you ask for. Keep on seeking, and you will find. Keep on knocking and the door will be opened for you."

In my own experience and with those to whom I minister, it is very easy to let hurt and disappointment keep us from believing that God is at work, but he is. When we keep on asking, seeking, and knocking with people, we can be disappointed, but we can keep asking, seeking, and knocking with God because he listens and cares, and he wants to answer our prayers. Our God is faithful in an unfaithful world. He is faithful when we are not. He wants to prove his love for us if we will believe in him.

Ask God what you want him to do for you this Christmas, and wait in expectation for his gift for you. He doesn't come down a chimney with a big red bag of toys; he does something better – he comes into our hearts with his love, and he is willing and able to grant us the desires of our hearts (Psalm 37:4).
